The exhibition will provide students with an opportunity to explore and learn about the historical and architectural features of the Indian Parliament through Google Earth.

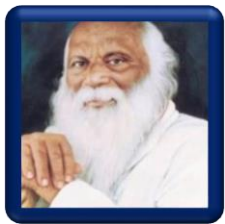

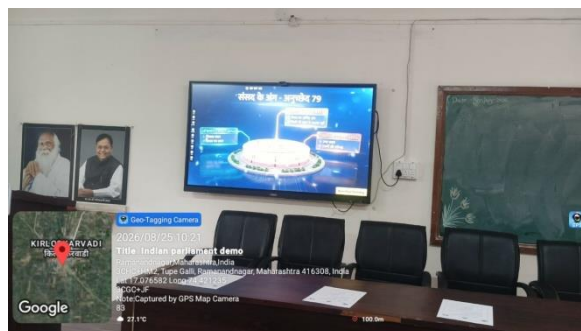
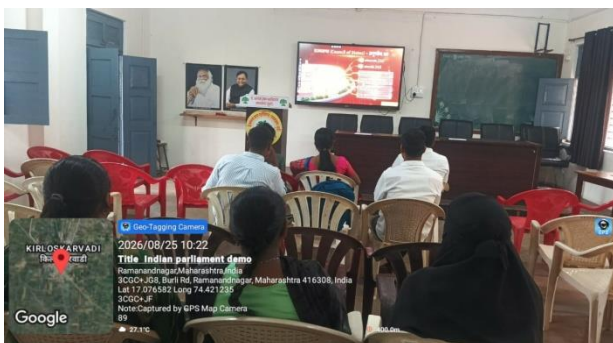
