On 20th December 2025 in the Seminar Hall of the College. In today's competitive job market, especially in the banking sector, students require not only subject knowledge but also strong communication skills, confidence, and interview readiness. Considering this need, The activity was designed to bridge the gap between academic learning and professional expectations by providing students with real-time interview experience similar to actual bank recruitment processes.

A total of **42 students** from the college and BCA actively participated in the mock interview process. These students were aspiring candidates for upcoming bank recruitment examinations and interviews.

- Handling interview pressure
- Answer framing techniques
- Professional behavior and interview etiquette

This feedback helped students understand their strengths and identify areas requiring improvement.
